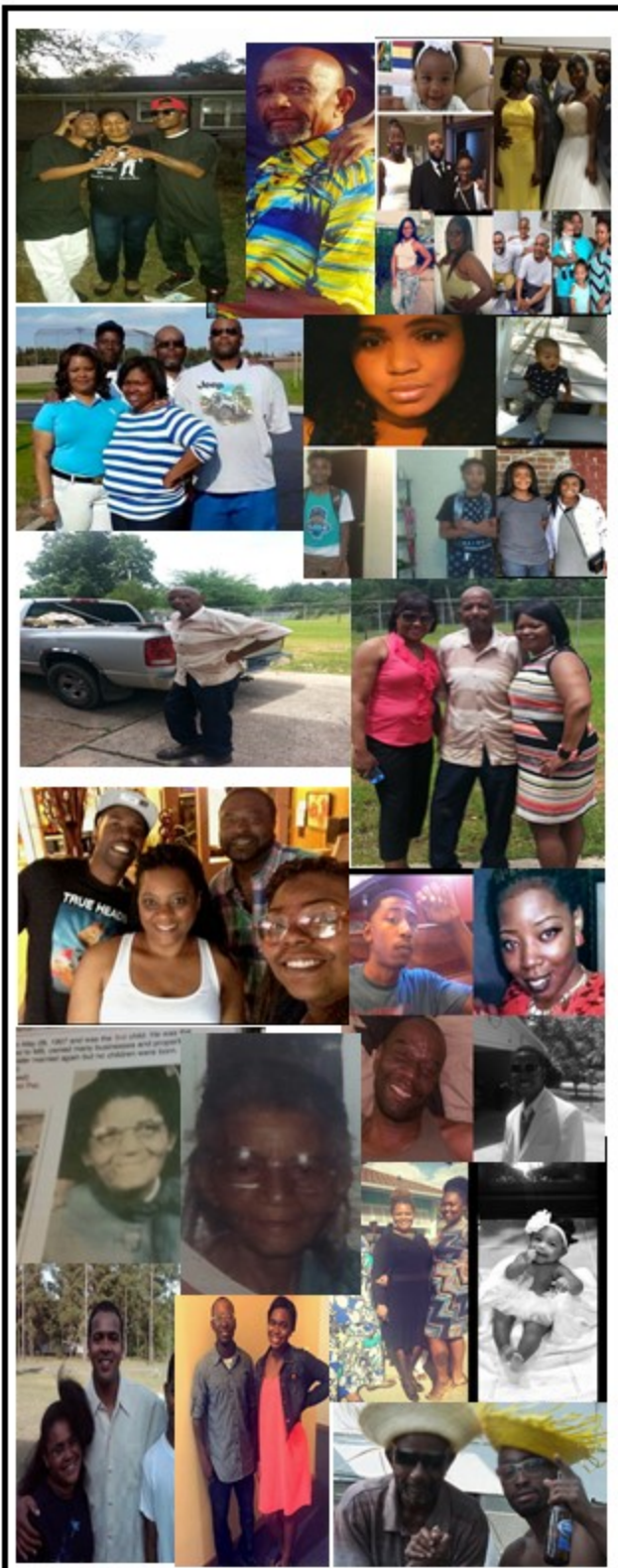
Life and Legacy
