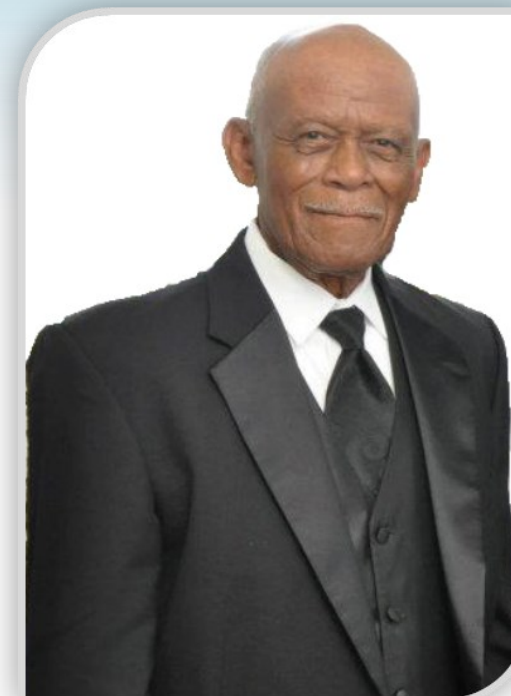

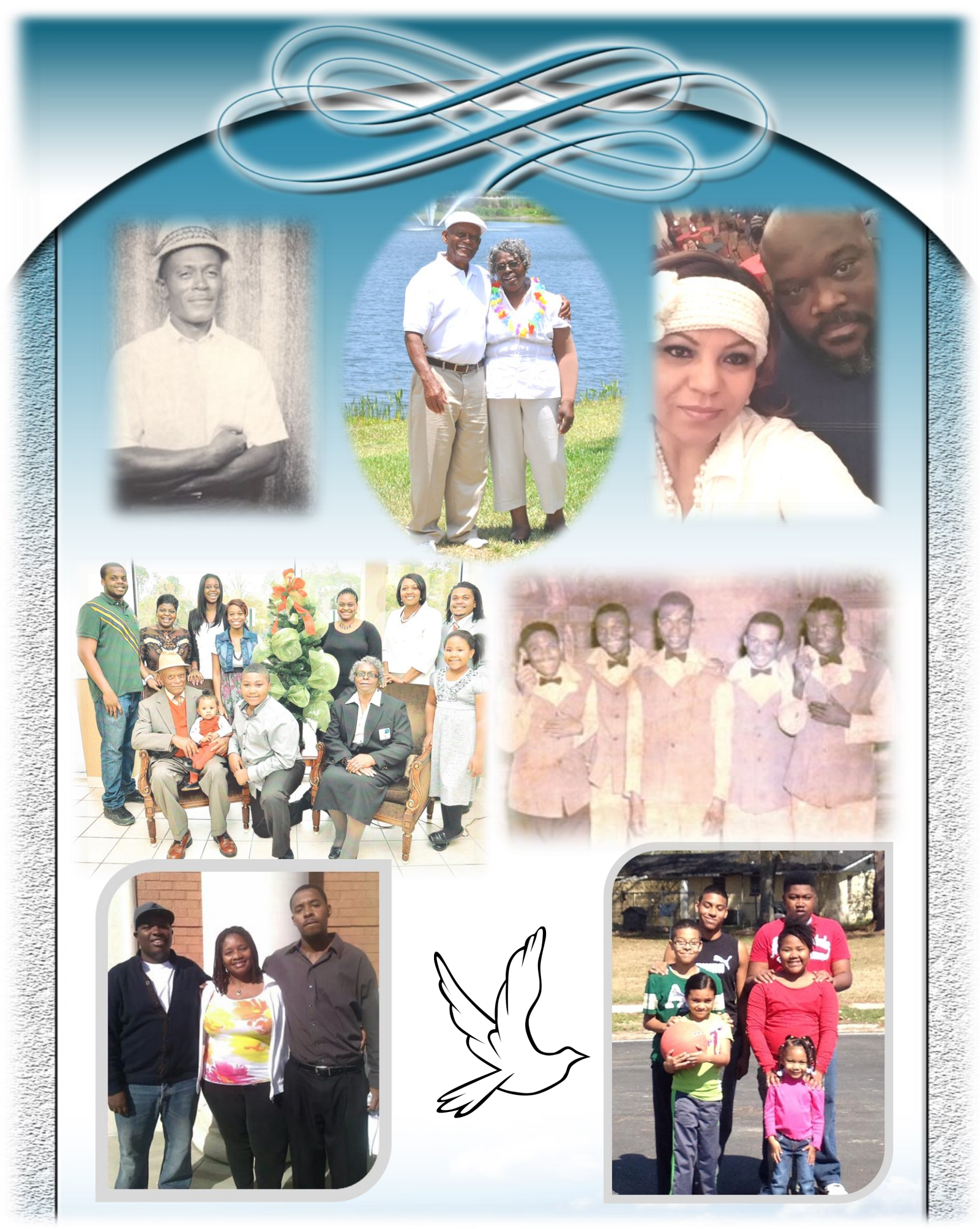
Transitioned to Heaven: March 18, 2014
