God blessed this world with the birth of a wonderful son, Christopher "Chris" Tyson born November 15, 1969 to Shepard Williams and Bernita Buchanan.

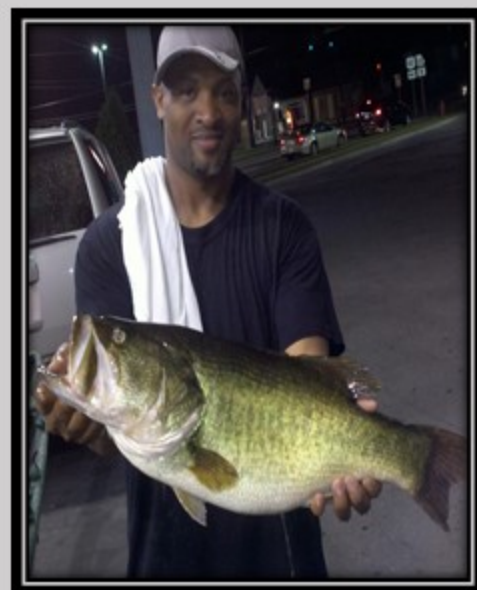
