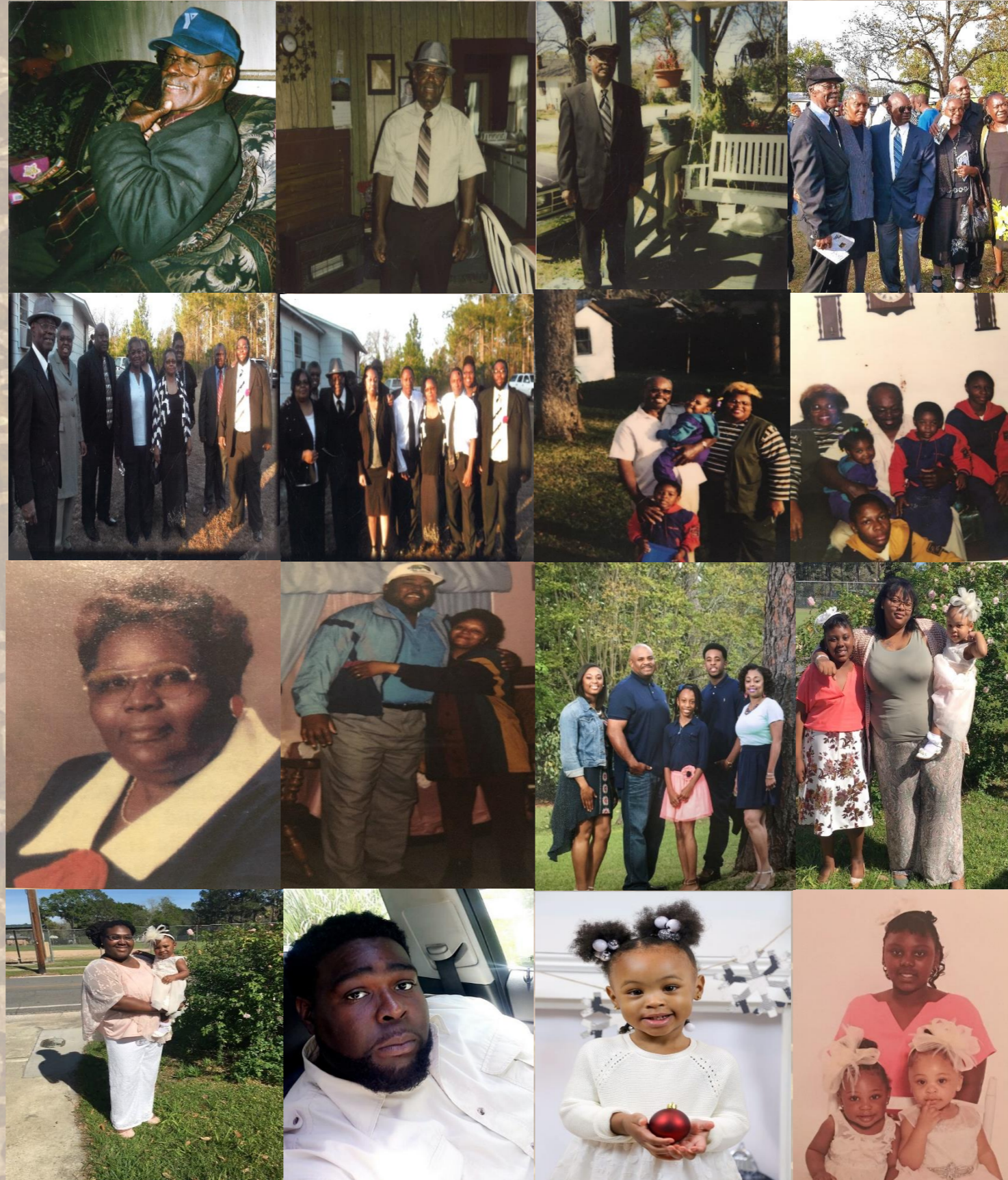
## Life Reflections
