Mrs. Clara Cleroy Walker Robinson was born on February 9, 1957, to the late Helen Scott Walker and late Earnest Fred Walker.

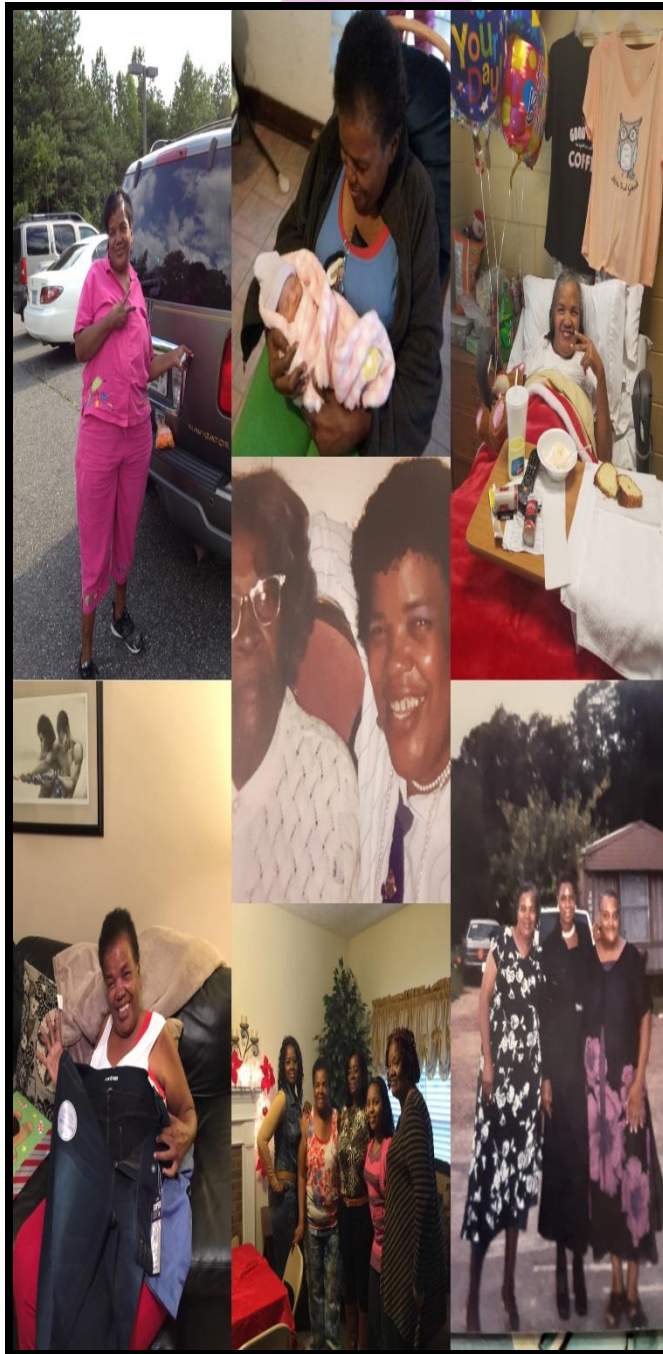
Clara was a member of Macedonia Baptist Church. She worked with the young children ushering until her health failed.
