Our God's gentle soul, Cyrus Aloysius Allen, was born in Douglas, Georgia, on April 1, 1960, to the late Mary Alice (Brock) Allen and Horace Allen. Raised in Rochester, New York, Cyrus graduated from Madison High School and attended SUNY Brockport College and the University of Rochester.

After attending SUNY Brockport, where he studied Broadcast Journalism and interned at the school radio station, Cyrus went on to develop his passion for radio broadcasting at WRUR 88.5 FM Radio, University of Rochester, Rochester, NY. After a short time, Cyrus went on to spend much of his adult life as a well-known radio personality at WDKX 103.9 FM Radio (Rochester, NY), where he worked for over 30 years in various capacities - Radio Air Personality/Producer/Director/Engineer. On the airwaves, he was a celebrity in his own right, affectionately known as "The Love Sponge," and after busy days, he comforted and helped bring calm to his many loyal listeners during his nightly Quiet Storm broadcast. During a brief period in Australia, Cyrus continued his passion for radio broadcasting, where he was an on-air personality for iHeart Radio 96. One FM the Edge, in Sydney, Australia. In 2015, Cyrus returned to Atlanta to be near family. His last employer was Wal Mart Corporation.

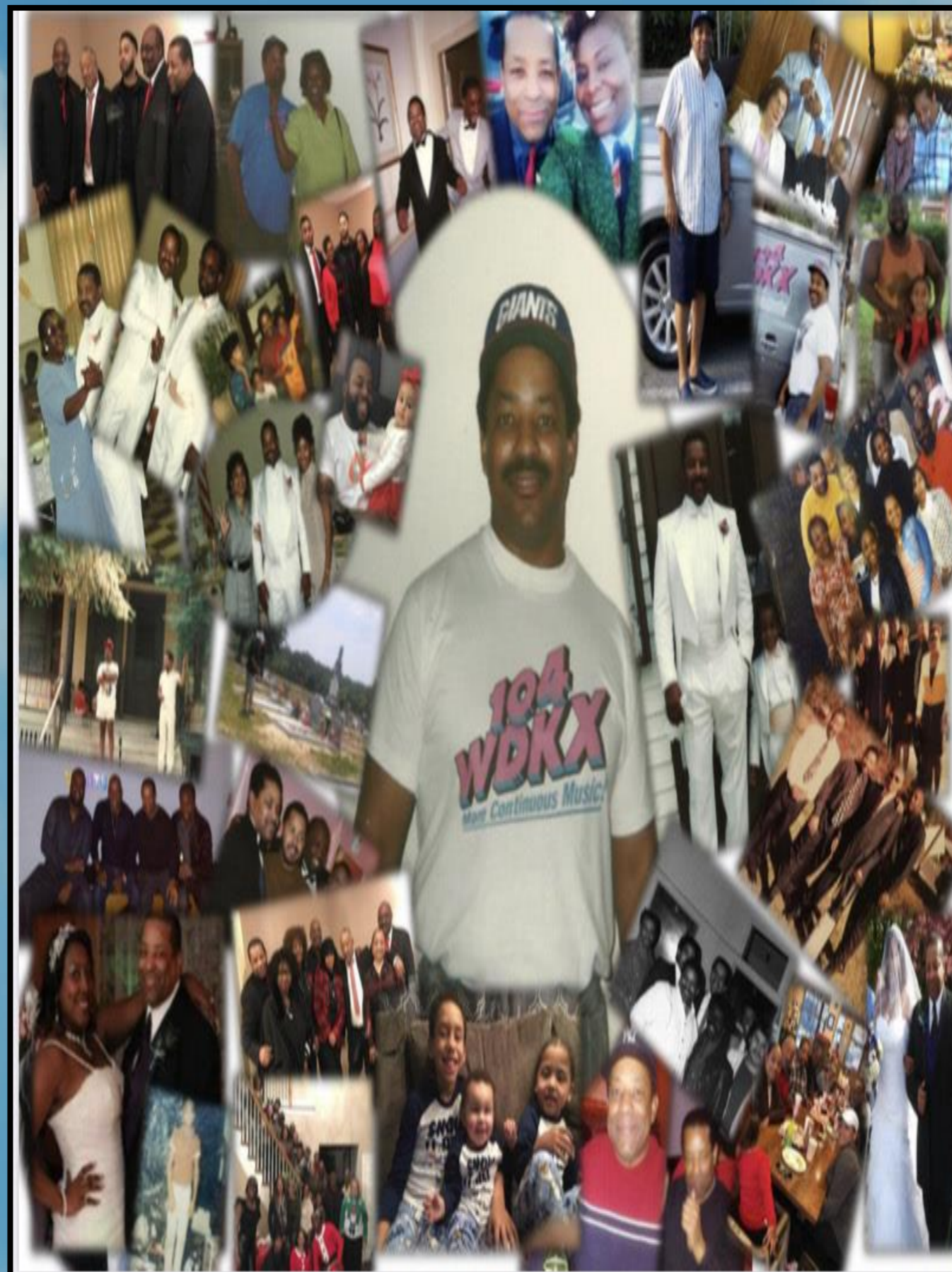
