# Life Reflections

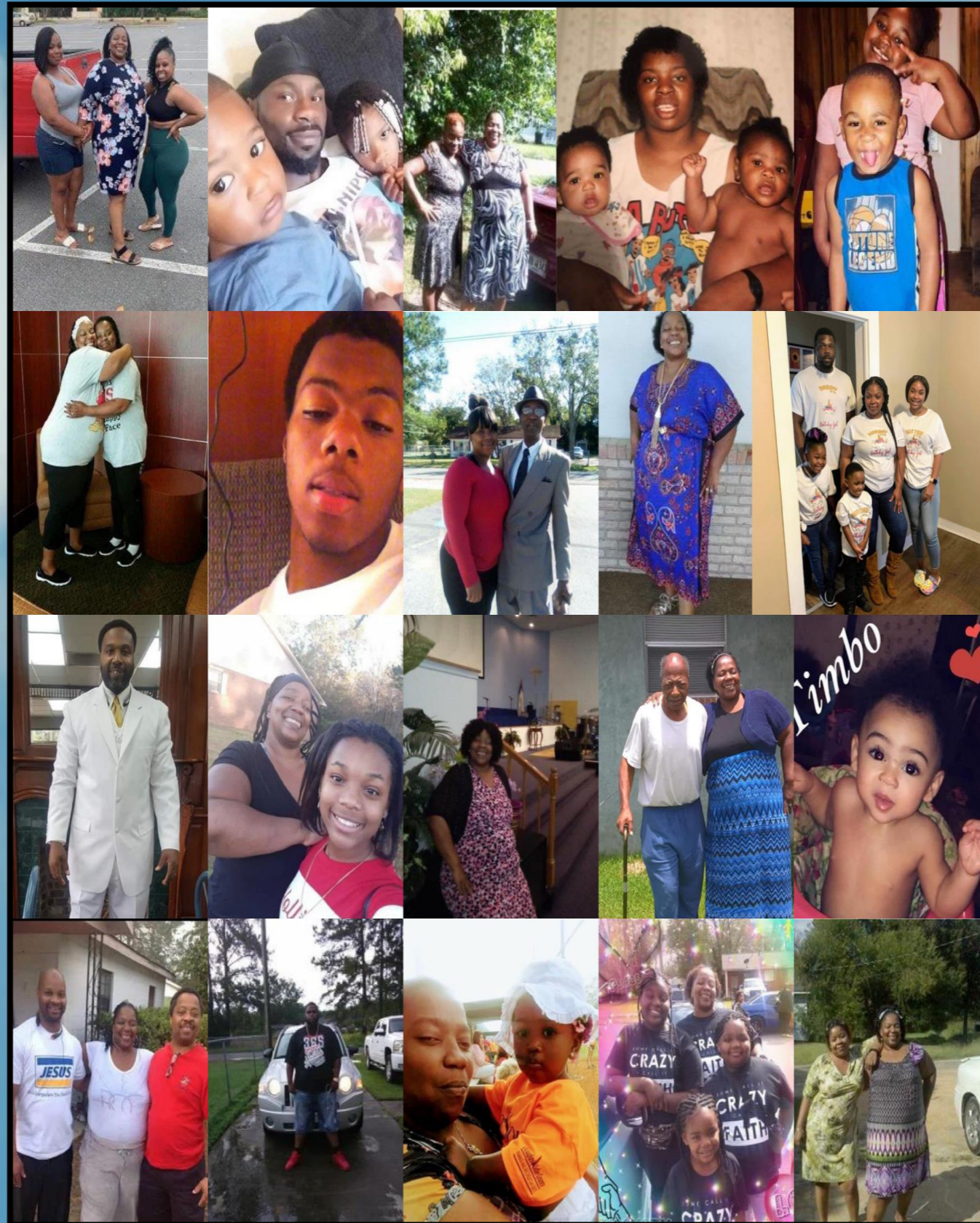
