Remembering Margie

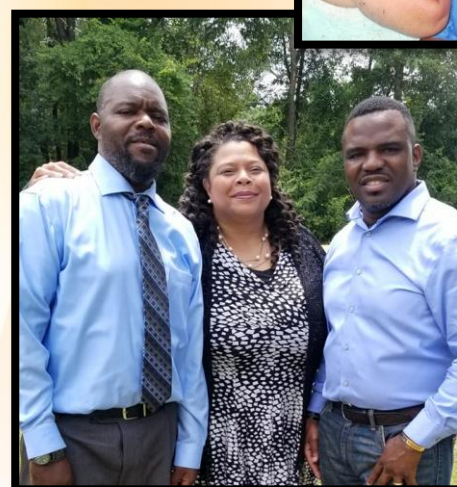
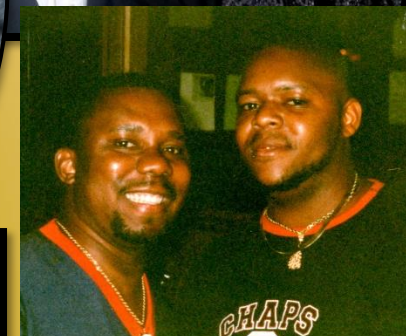
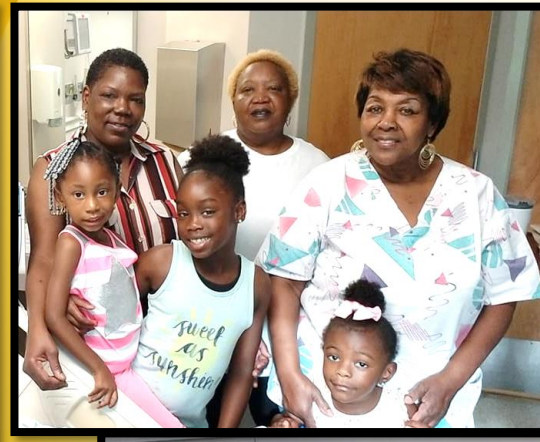

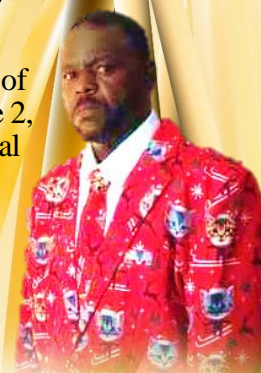
Margie was preceded in death by her only son, Tyrandal Cortez Grady and sister, Gloria Jean Grady.
