Lamar McFadden of Valdosta, Georgia, passed away on April 29th, 2022, at the age of 68 from a long battle with cancer.

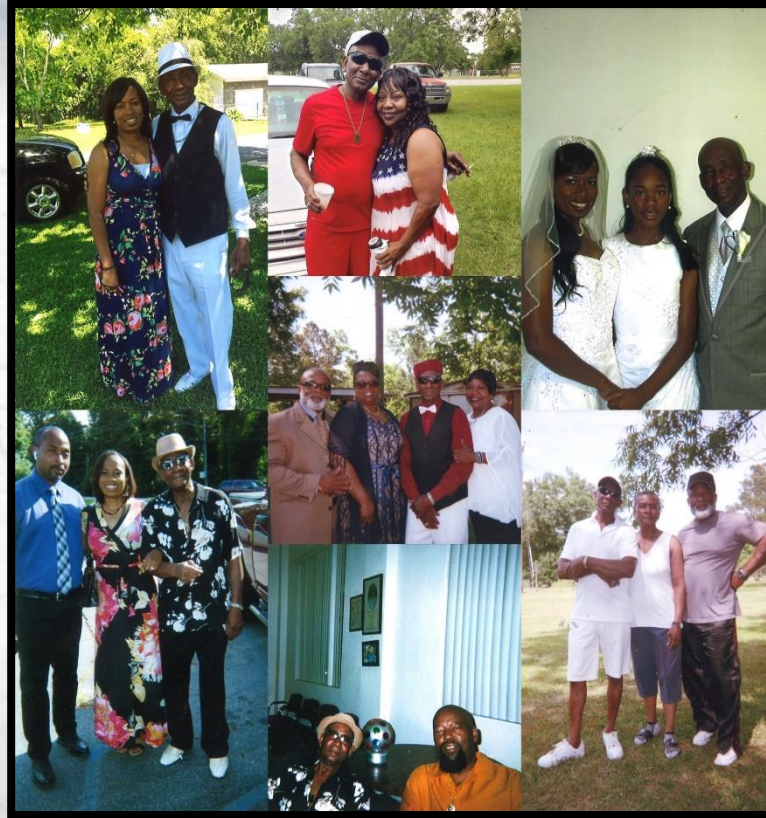
