Obituary

Mother Lottie “Mommie” Washington, 87 of Douglas, Georgia, transitioned peacefully on April 18, 2022. Mrs. Washington was born September 6, 1934, in Nashville, Georgia, the daughter of the late Jack McRae and the former Mother Alice “Granny” Johnson McRae. She graduated from South Georgia College with a degree in Criminal Justice and Valdosta State University with a Master’s degree in Education.

Mrs. Washington married Jim Washington Jr., in Douglas, Georgia in 1951. Jim passed away in March 2014. She worked as a Science Teacher and was Head of the Science Department at Coffee Junior High and East Coffee Middle School. After serving as a dedicated teacher for twenty-five years, under principals Clayton Mathis, Oscar Street, and Yvonne Fletcher, Mrs. Washington retired in May 2000.

Mommie loved cooking, plundering, walking the track, and spending quality time with her family. She also enjoyed frequent visits from her sister, Betty, almost every day after school.

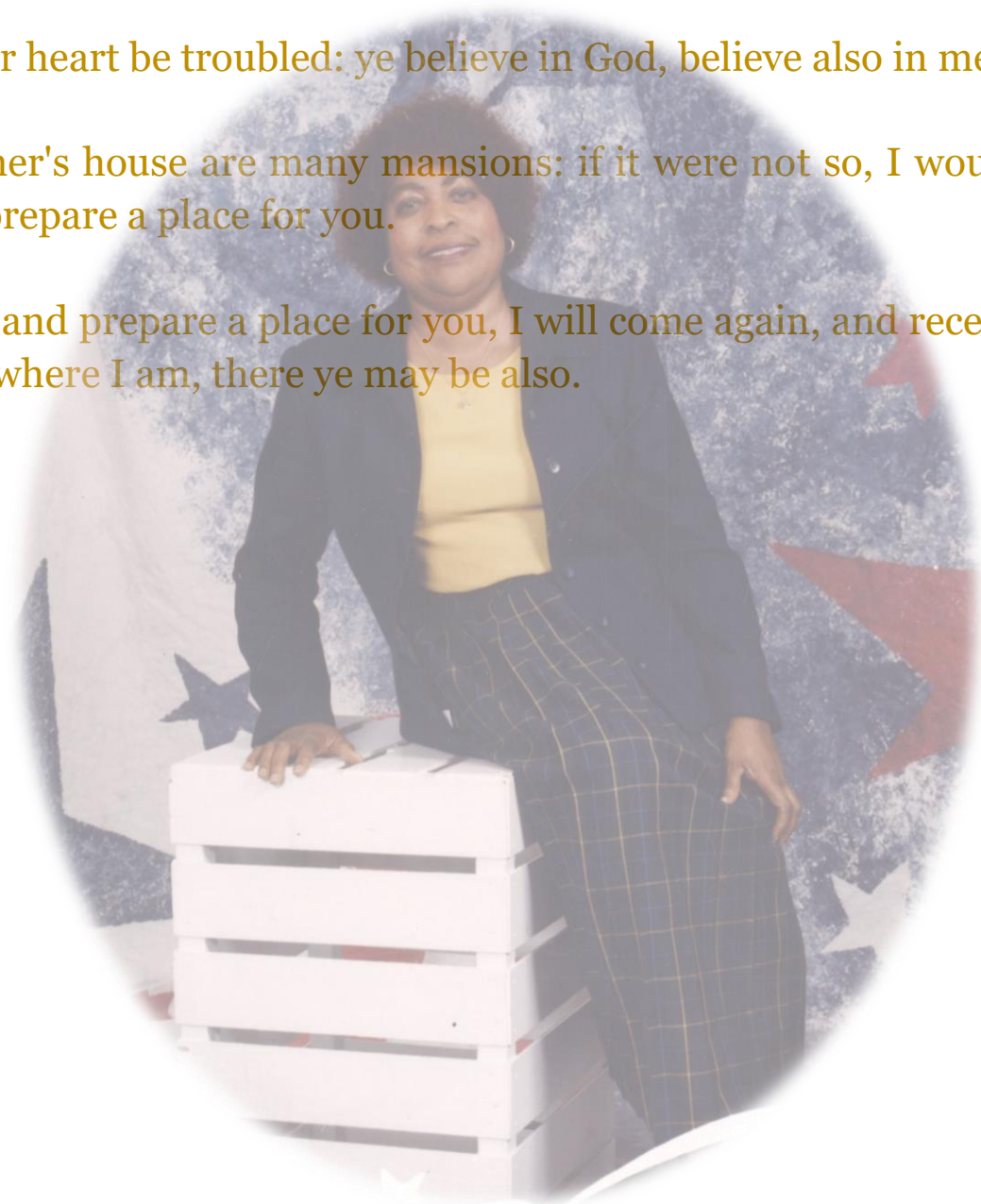


John 14: 1-3

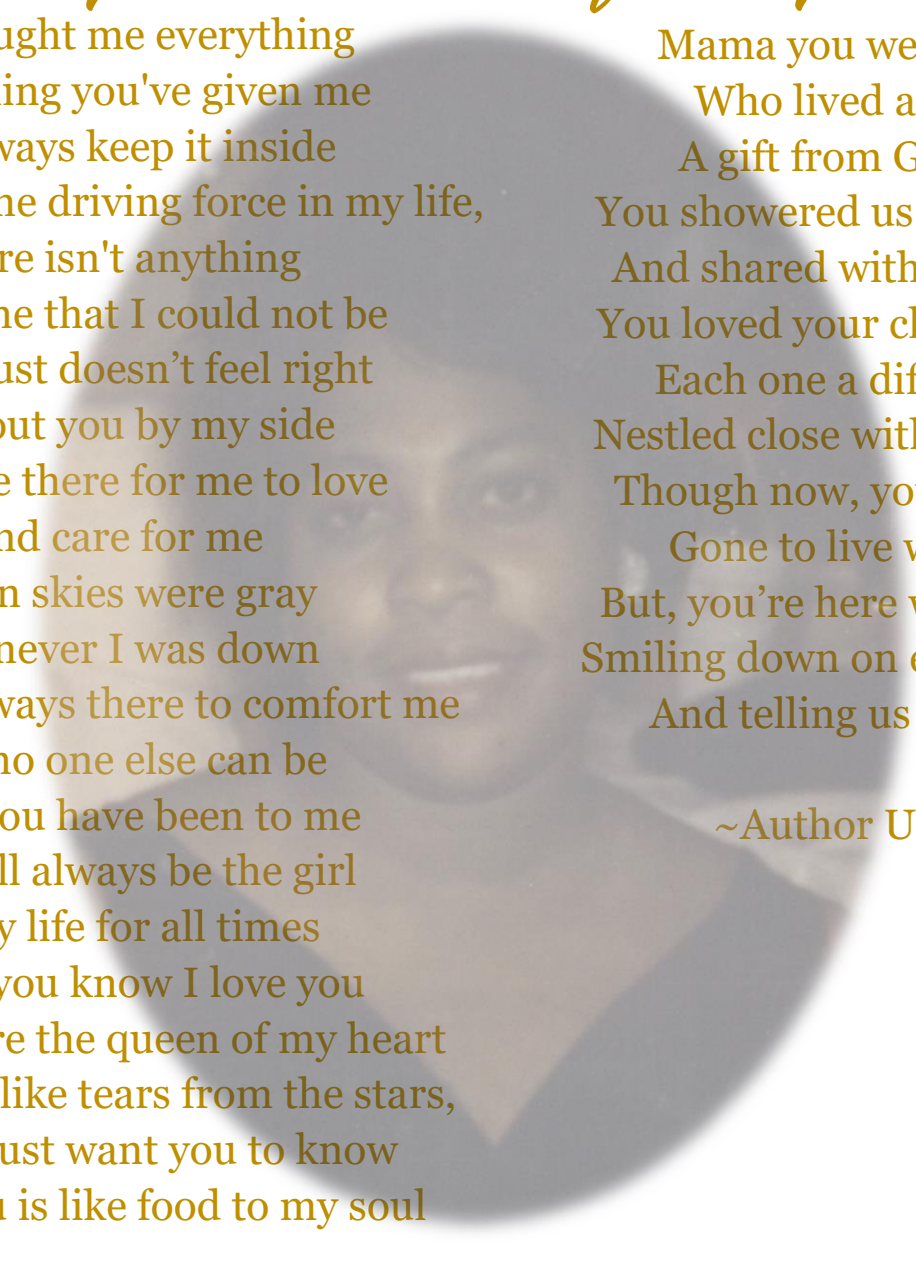


Always the Queen of My Heart
