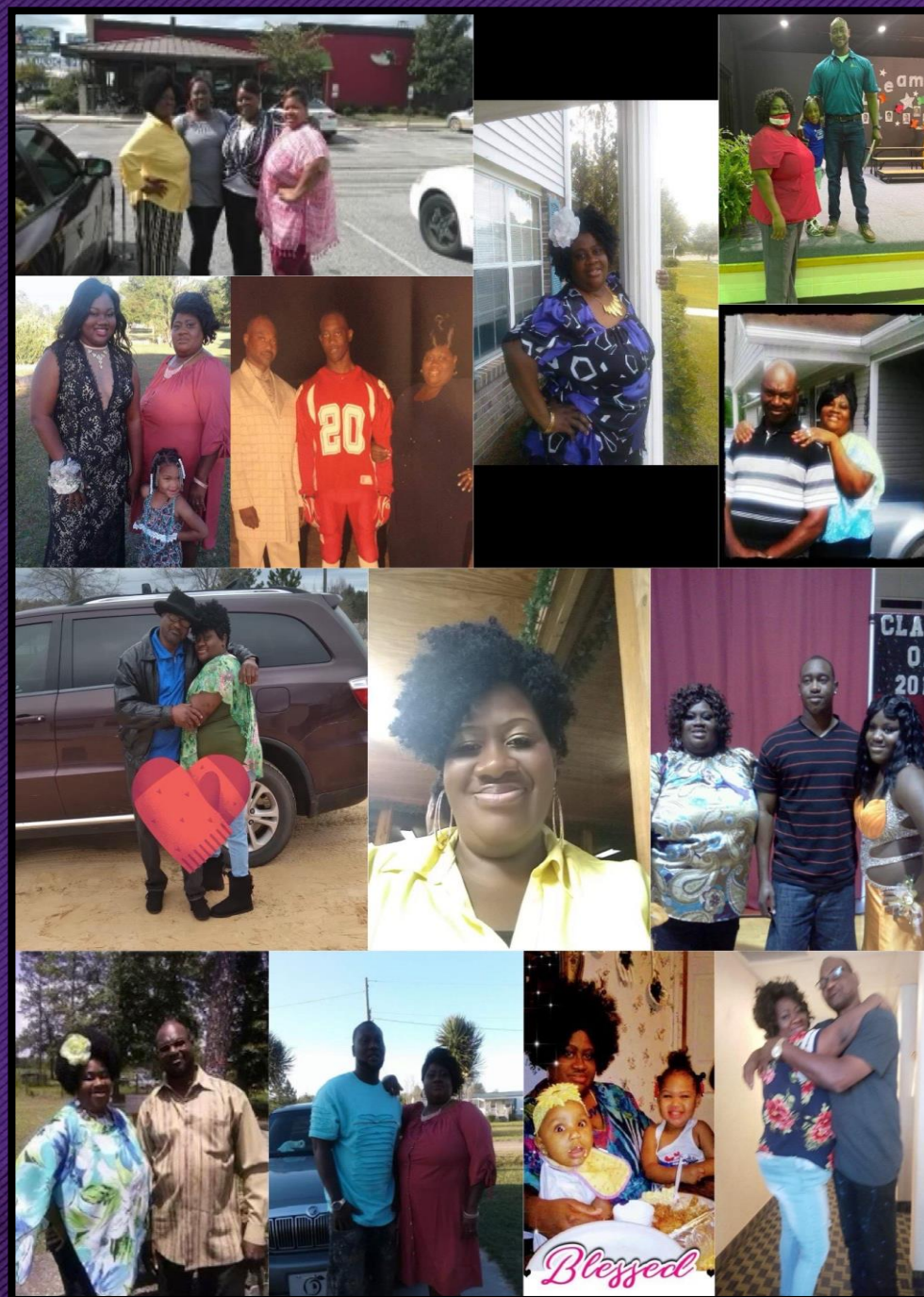


Alicia Core Vickers was born on August 23, 1974, to Walter L. Johnson Sr. and Charlene Core in Homerville, Georgia.
