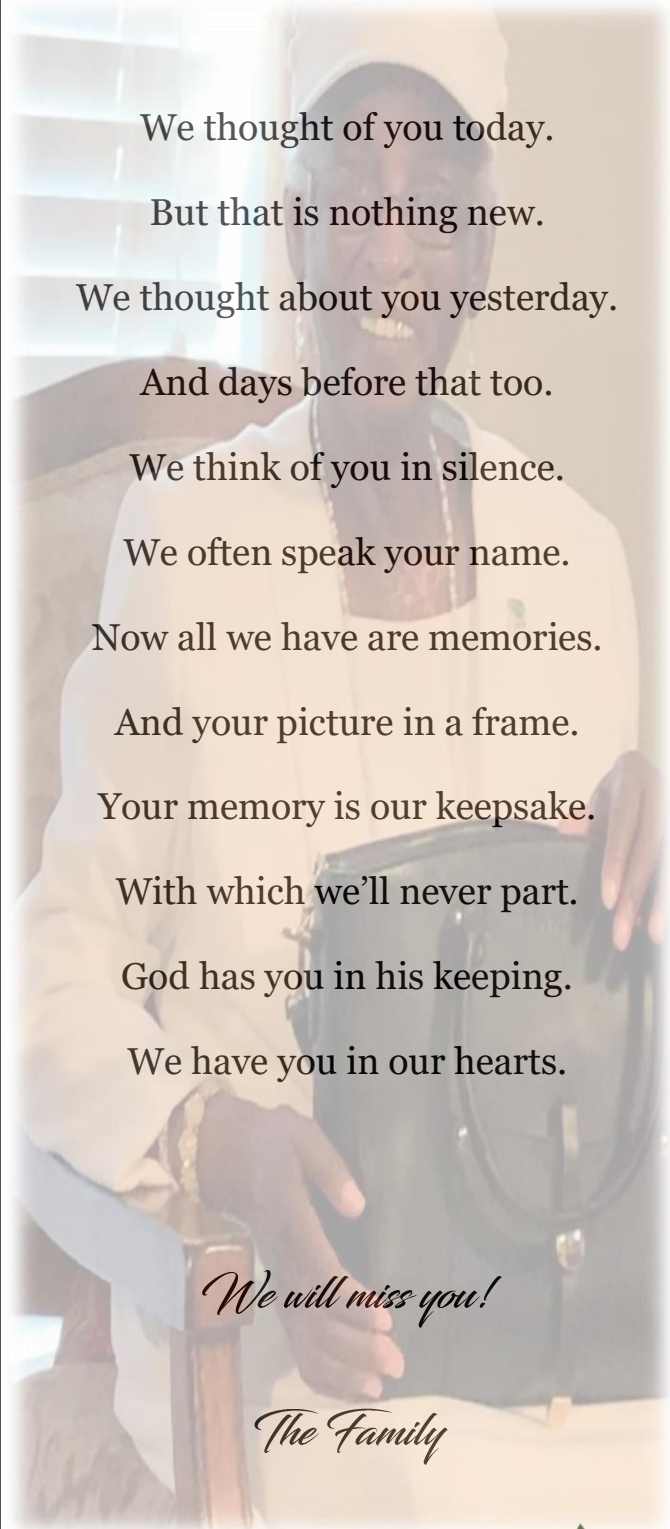




*In Our Hearts*

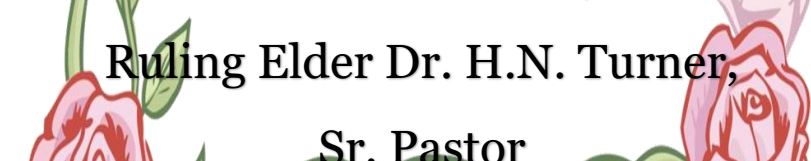
