Until that fine day we're together again.



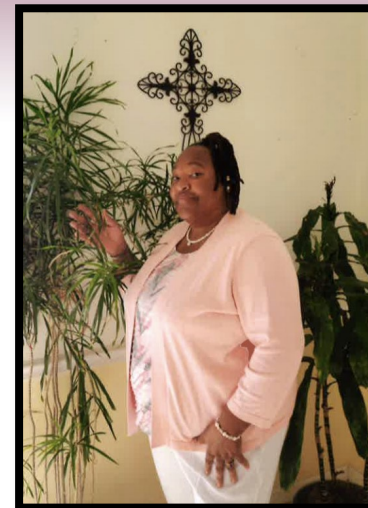
