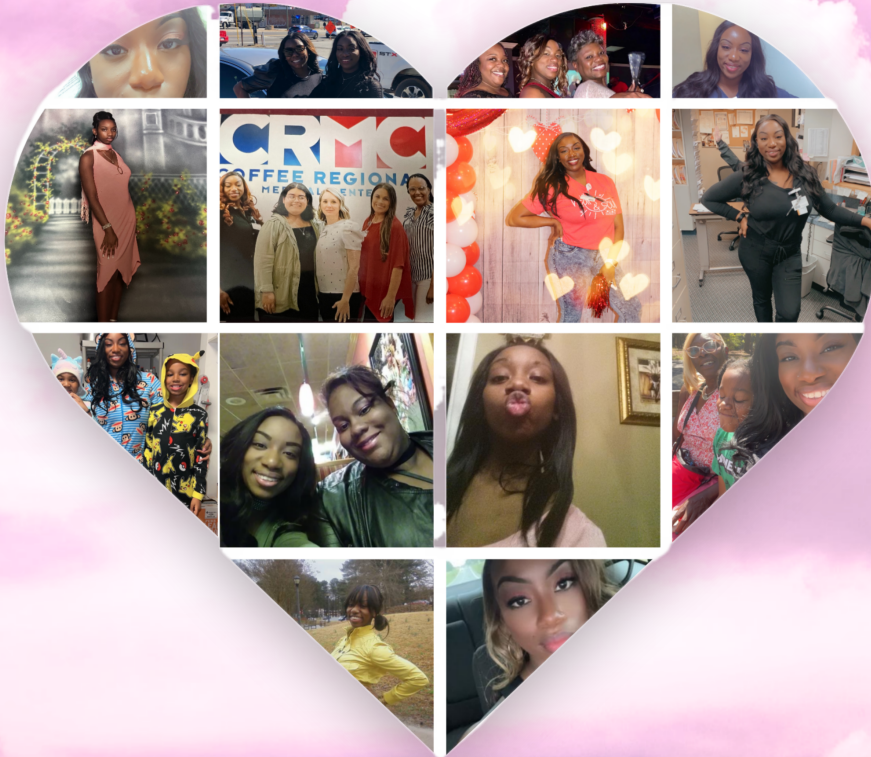

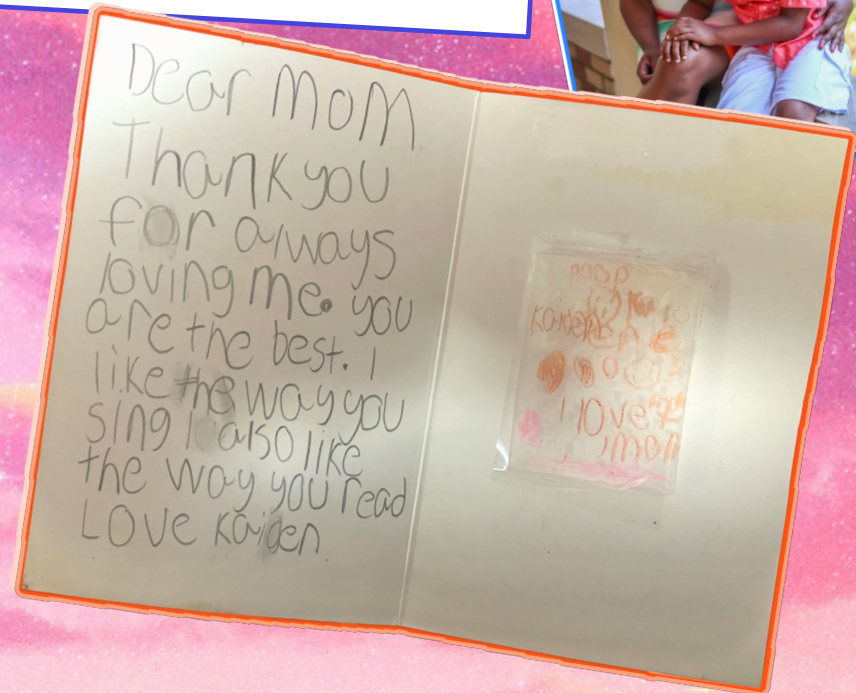

And took me by the hand

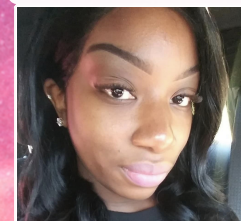
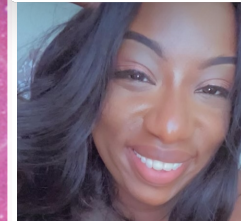
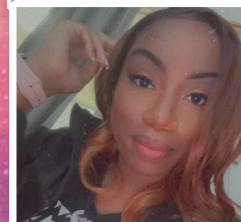
The angel said my place was ready
