Mamie V. Johnson Marshall was born on October 13, 1961, in Chester, Dodge County, Georgia, to the late Eli Victrum and Velma Dillard Victrum Sears.

After graduating from high school, she attended South Georgia College in Douglas, Georgia, where she met her late husband, Ronnie R. Johnson. Together they were blessed with two children. A talented athlete, Mamie loved basketball and played throughout both high school and college.

Mamie faithfully served the State of Georgia for 35 years. She began her career with the Coffee County Police Department as a secretary, later became a 911 operator, and then joined the Georgia State Patrol as a driver's license examiner. After the agency became the Georgia Department of Driver Services, she advanced to the position of Manager, serving with excellence until her retirement.

A woman of unwavering faith, Mamie was a devoted member of Sears Street Church of Faith by Faith under the leadership of Ruling Elder Turner and Pastor Terrance Walker, where she served in the choir and praise team.
